**ANCBH Collaboration, work, and meetings with:**

Worked with NCAPHA-Tolson/Committee- concerning RFA # A202 on Board of Health Training, December 7 & 14.. Serving on The Healthy Youth Act Collaborative(HYAC) to insure proper implementation of HB 88. On Wednesday, January 20, the AHA announced the 2020 Impact Goal: *"By 2020, to improve the cardiovascular health of all Americans by 20 percent while reducing death from cardiovascular diseases and stroke by 20 percent."* This goal will impact program work during the coming year in areas of obesity and nutrition. Several ANCBH members have been active in January conference calls with NALBOH, SALBOH, and HYAC. A presentation was made on Public Health Issues on January 22 to the NCCPH.

**Accreditation:**

The NCLHDA Board is working on a Business Plan including possible future funding models for the program. Accreditation continues to be a priority for boards of health.

**Legislation:**

Our board supports the reinstatement of the state vaccine appropriation in the 2010 budget. We are monitoring the case management situation and the Health Directors committee working on a new state health plan. Legislative committees on the new plan and another on obesity are currently meeting. As legislative committees continue to meet during this time, we must be ever alert for action and input..

- Budget
  - Good News-No cuts in Aid to Counties Funds for current year
    - Payment is made monthly based on Expenditure Report (\$500/mo)
  - DEH required to submit 3%, 5%, 7% cuts in appropriations for FY2010-11
    - At the 5% & 7% level, significant cuts in Aid to Counties and DEH positions (RIF), possibly whole programs
- Rules in 2010
  - .2500 Swimming Pools will be presented at Feb 17 Commission for Public Health meeting
  - .2633 Dogs in Dining Areas will be in Feb 1 edition of NC Register. Public hearing on Feb 16. Allows pets in unenclosed areas
  - .2600 Food Rules amendments to align with Food Code. Sometime in 2010
  - .2400 Schools having fiscal note prepared
  - .1700 Water Supplies - *this year*
  - .3100 Lead will have minor changes to match Federal standards
  - .3800 VOC Testing has last Stakeholder meeting on Jan 28
- REHS Board
  - Rule Revisions should appear in the Feb 15 edition of NC Register
  - Public hearings: March 12 in Newton, March 22 in Raleigh
  - Janice Jones, Adm Asst for the Board has resigned, effective Jan 31. Replacement will be announced soon.
