OVERVIEW

The [Continuous Quality Improvement \(CQI\) Advisor Program](#) is an interactive, six-month learning program designed to train staff from health-focused organizations to become quality improvement (QI) leaders and change agents. Participants receive mentoring by a national expert QI coach to learn how to provide QI support within their organization to improve performance and create and sustain a continuous quality improvement culture and infrastructure (also called Performance Management).

The program fosters an environment of shared learning intended to hone your skills as a CQI Advisor through practical and experiential application of proven methods. Upon completion of the program, participants will receive a CQI Advisor Certificate and be prepared to drive quality improvement efforts in their organization.

BENEFITS

The benefits of the program to participants and their organizations include:

- the ability to lead projects that create substantial savings (typically tens of thousands of dollars) and return on investment for the organization,
- leadership and team-building skills that will enhance their entire career and organization,
- ability to train all staff in the organization to use QI methods and tools in their daily work,
- onsite support and coaching on a quality improvement project by a national expert, as well as knowledge of how to sustain organizational improvements.
