

**Core Public Health Committee Meeting
December 7, 2016**

- Family Planning RFA: Results – Belinda Pettiford
 - 83 applications received, all from local health departments; one Letter of Intent from another organization but DPH did not receive an application; two counties did not submit applications so the deadline for submission was extended until tomorrow
- AA: Mosquito and Vector Control Funds – Jennifer Stewart (on behalf of Larry Michael)
 - AA for Zika funding is almost complete and is similar to current year's
 - Ten counties throughout the state were invited to participate: response from 7, one declined and waiting on a response from 2 others
 - Allocation is approximately \$27,000 each; participating counties will respond to needs of neighboring counties (ie. locally-acquired case of Zika)
 - Dr. Carl Williams will provide a powerpoint
