

DRAFT Tobacco Prevention Funding 2017-18

The North Carolina General Assembly appropriated \$500,000 per year in non-recurring funds in FY17-18 and FY18-19 for youth tobacco use prevention. The budget provides funding to develop strategies to prevent the use of new and emerging tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes by youth and people of childbearing age. Below is a DRAFT of the funding allocations to be presented to the NC Association of Local Health Directors for approval on 8/17/17.
